INSTRUCTIONS TO CONTRIBUTORS:

All communications concerning editorial matters/manuscripts/books for reviews (in duplicate) for publication in the Bulletin should be addressed to at e-mail address: cri.bulletin.kolkata@gmail.com. Contributors are advised to send their manuscripts through e-mail. The manuscript should be typed in MS Word 97 or higher version; preferred fonts are Calibri, font size being 12 point; figures and pictures having more than 300 dpi for better clarity. Abstract of the paper in approximately 150 – 200 words should be sent with the manuscript.

The title of the paper, author's name and affiliation, mailing address, e-mail ID, contact phone number should appear on the first page of the article for future communication. Footnote text should be placed as endnotes. Tables, illustrations and diagrams should be placed at the right place inside the text. References should be listed at the end of the article and arranged alphabetically according to the surnames of the authors and in chronological order.
